

May Prayer Letter 2015

Dear Friends in Christ,

This letter is to inform you that I have returned to Zimbabwe in May 2015 to continue the missionary work which I started way back in 1998 on my first visit. This is actually my 8th visit to this great country. I am delighted to return and to reconnect with my friends and fellow workers in the ministry. It was such a joy to preach my first sermon at Nashville Baptist Church on Mother's Day and to hear the 8 orphans from House of Hope sing a wonderful song that really blessed my heart.

The House of Hope Committee met on Mother's Day to plan for the future direction of the Orphanage. We have decided that instead of continuing to pay rent as we have for the past 4 years, to house the children, it would be wiser to build our own house. In fact, that is wise stewardship. Therefore we are counting on you to help us to keep these precious children by building a 3 bed roomed house for them. We cannot do it alone, but with your assistance, it will become a reality. For a start, it will take 3000 blocks @US\$1.10 to build this home, and it takes about 400 bags of cement @ US \$10.00 each. Please let us know how many blocks or how many bags of cement you can give toward this project.

If House of Hope is to succeed, we are counting on you to stand behind us and support the worthy cause on a regular basis. The children on Zimbabwe do not enjoy the privilege of free education like the children in the Caribbean. The school fees for primary education is US \$25.00 per month for each child. Would you like to sponsor the school fee for one of these orphans? Please let us know.

If you have already given to House of Hope we are indeed grateful for your contribution and we are kindly asking you to continue to give so that the doors will always be open to help these children. The Bible says that one of the marks of pure religion is to care for the fatherless and widows in their affliction (James 1.5). The Lord will bless you for helping these children to see a better day and a brighter tomorrow. If you plan to send money, you may send it through Western Union or Money Gram.
