Folks, Lord willing, we are all going back to the Solomon Islands on August 27th. God is so good! We have begun to see steady improvements in Nora's health. Although it will be a long road to full recovery, her doctor is confident that she has had the kick start she needed to continue healing back home in the Islands. Yes, she still has bad days, but her good days are becoming more frequent. We will finish treatments with her doctor, here, on the 21st of August. After that, we will make our way to Missouri where we will spend the weekend with my parents and our sending church before we depart the following Tuesday. Words cannot express the joy we have in our hearts as we anticipate our return to the field.

Our hearts are blessed beyond measure by what God is doing with Pacific Light Baptist Church. Last week we rejoiced to hear that a young lady, Jacklyn, made a profession of salvation. Jacklyn's story is special to us because we have both worked with her. Nora first made contact with her when her baby girl was sick in the hospital. She was able to visit, witness to, and encourage Jacklyn before she left in August of last year. After Nora left, I continued to visit her and her baby girl in the hospital until I left for my visit to the states in November 2018.
