We are happy to report that Pacific Light Baptist Church is doing really well. Every week I record and send a video Bible lesson to the church that they play during their Sunday school hour. Twice every month we try to do a video call with the church during their fellowship time. We are able to have short one on one conversations with them to see how they are doing or answer any questions they may have. We are very thankful for technology. We often receive photos from the church and we marvel at how the people are sticking together and remaining faithful. It's a blessing to see their fellowship and hearts knit together. God has given us an amazing group of people to form the core of Pacific Light Baptist Church. We cannot wait to get back and rejoin them in reaching the Solomon Islands with the gospel.
