Dear Praying Saints,

Yesterday I was reminded vividly by our great and powerful Savior how His protection and power are so evident in our lives. We travel several times a week to the city in which we are planting the church. On my way yesterday, I came across a traffic accident. It appeared to involve three tractor-trailers and a small sedan. From what I could tell, one of the trucks tried to pass another going uphill and the sedan crested the opposite hill coming down. Yes, the car ended up at the bottom of the hill upside down and completely destroyed. During my visits, I discovered that the mother of one of our people knew the family in the accident. The entire family went into eternity, a man, his wife, and a young girl. On my return trip, as I crested a hill, I saw headlights in my lane. Yes, a tractor-trailer passing another going uphill. The Lord protected, I saw it in time, and he made it back into the lane before we met. Later down the road, two trucks passing in the opposite direction flashed their lights at me in essence warning, "something in the road up ahead!" Sure enough as I rounded a curve, I passed the most dangerous weapon on a Brazilian highway, a stray cow! I was listening to a piece of music based on the verse above. I thanked God for His protection and His protection of our family. Thank you for your constant prayers on our behalf.

Speaking of prayer, I was reminded recently by the Lord about how needed prayer is in my own life. With great joy, I can announce that after working and evangelizing, Clénio and his brother Alcemir trusted Christ as their Savior last week. Neide, Clénio's wife, is close. I had been praying for God to work, and in the work had forgotten to pray. Our people began asking about prayer, and the Lord laid on my heart the need to teach our people about prayer, but I recognized that I was lacking in that area myself. After praying specifically for Clénio for a week, I went to visit him and the night that I got there Satan tried to do everything to keep me from the visit. My car overheated, another person called needing an emergency visit, and after the visit the car overheated again. I prayed for the Lord to allow me to make it to Clénio's house. When I got there I understood why I was having the problems that night, Clénio was ready to trust Christ! What made the night even better was when I got home. The kids were all in bed, but Cynthia got Morgan out of bed to come talk to me. She had not told him anything, but she told him to ask me about my visits.
