Most Saturday evenings we men are sitting around here until 10 waiting for the ladies to finish. A little more than a year ago, our landlord asked us to move out and after much looking and praying we began renting and moved into what is known here as a "chácara". The house is amazing, and there is much land. We have enjoyed every day here, but we have prayed about how the Lord would want us to use it. Covid came to town and everything locked down, but the Lord opened a door. On our very large front porch, we have been able to hold open air services on Sunday nights with increasing attendance each week. Our folks have missed the fellowship so this ministry opportunity has been met with great enthusiasm. Also, with the talents of our folks and the addition of the Smothers Family, we have been able to begin a small "orchestra". We are hopeful that "holding fast" to the ministry God has given us will reap eternal fruit here in the interior of Brazil even in the midst of so much change going on all around
