It is an annual conference that raises money for church planters in the Northeast. As my turn came up, I presented our ministry of planting a deaf church in Philadelphia and it was a new concept to most of the people in the crowd. Whenever I get the chance to share God's Word, more often than not, most of the audience has never seen a deaf pastor, let alone heard of a

deaf church. The more I travel on deputation, the more it strikes me to see how prevalent this is. During the conference, a considerable sum of money was raised that is enough to be equivalent to 4% of my support for the next five years, which should be about long enough until my next furlough!
