Meetings + Car Replacement

During November and December, we traveled to churches in Maryland, Delaware, Connecticut, and Georgia. I was thankful to participate in two deaf Bible conferences during this time: Deaf Spiritual Leadership Conference with local deaf pastors in GA and an online International Deaf Bible Conference where we had about 20 deaf and hearing preachers preaching in sign language from their respective countries, mostly the USA and Peru. That last one was quite a blessing.

During our trip to CT, we had to stay overnight in PA to comply with covid rules as we could only stay in CT for less than 24 hours. NJ had the same rule so we stayed in PA where we were two hours away from the church in CT. On our way to the hotel in PA, our Kia Soul was rattling very bad for the last 30 minutes, the clutch bearing was slipping (we drive manual). So we had to cancel the meeting for the morning service. On Sunday morning we drove to the only open mechanic with two gears left and picked up a rental car, then went to our meeting for the evening instead. The mechanic came back with a price that was very high and we would have to stay for several days for him to get the parts. In the end, one of our supporting churches drove all the way to where we were and towed our car back home and then took care of the repairs! We're extremely thankful for this beyond


New Support Increase
