In May and June, we had many meetings and five conferences. While that was a lot more socializing than I'm accustomed to, I am grateful for the new network and friends we made along the way. We visited Massachusetts, Connecticut, Tennessee, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Georgia, Alabama and Washington DC. God even blessed us with several new meetings from each conference.

My "Macedonian moment"

One of those conferences was a deaf revival at Solid Rock Baptist Church's deaf ministry in southern New Jersey. While chatting around, I came across a hearing ASL interpreter from Philadelphia. In our conversation, he told me that he has been praying for a deaf pastor to come to Philly for the last three years. Immediately, I had goosebumps. That is exactly how long I have been on deputation now and this man whom I have never met has been praying for me this whole time. (Our deputation started in the summer of 2018.) I thought of Paul's vision as he tried to travel into Asia but instead received a vision of a Macedonian man saying "Come over into Macedonia, and help us." (Acts 16:7). This proves that laborers will not go to the harvest if the laborers are not prayed for first (Matt 9:38). At this point, my heart is ready to move to Philadelphia and give them that help which only Jesus can provide. I truly believe that it should be goal of each Christian to receive such a burden and help others with the Gospel.

Deaf Baptist Fellowship of America

In June, I attended a conference in Georgia called the "Deaf Baptist Fellowship of America." We had a total of about 40 speakers, mostly deaf and some hearing who know sign language.
