A soul winning visit

I heard about a deaf man in Philadelphia who was just diagnosed with stage 4 cancer. A friend of his brought me to his house. Upon arrival, he was sleeping so we spoke with his family for a bit. When he awoke and talked with us, his first words were "I don't want to die." As he spoke about his medical condition for a few minutes, a nurse from the hospital came for a routine check, so we waited till he was done. After the nurse left, he was

ready to go back to sleep again. I left him with two tracts and asked him to read them. He let us pray with him before leaving. We tried to get in touch again afterwards but it seemed that his condition worsened really fast. It was tough as we went to his funeral.
