Dear Praying Friends,

Our hearts have been blessed to hear that we have been the focus of much prayer. Multiple churches have contacted us to let us know that we have been the featured missionary of the week or month while several churches have taken us on for support. We can't begin to tell you what a blessing this has been.

As the quarter began, I was asked to preach a three day revival to commemorate the 44th anniversary of the founding of the Calvary Baptist Church, our local church here on Pohnpei. We had a good crowd each evening with several of the local Baptist churches in attendance. We rejoice that during the conference, at least two people trusted Christ as their personal Savior, while many other decisions were made concerning service to our Lord.

Later in the month of July, we unexpectedly lost our FM transmitter. Thankfully, we had already been talking to a man on the island that had one he was looking to sell. I had hoped to use it as a back-up, but didn't think I'd need it so soon! Thankfully the FM was only off the air for a few days while the AM continued 24/7. Please pray that God would supply the funds needed to fix the original transmitter.

Thank you to those who answered our request for prayer for the students at the Calvary Christian Academy. During the opening revival at CCA, several students trusted Christ as Savior. I had the privilege of preaching the final service of the revival and, praise the Lord, one student trusted Christ while another received assurance of salvation. Amen!

At the end of August, we said goodbye to our missionary friends, Jack and Melinda Peeler. They had been here on Pohnpei since November of 2014, and living with us here at the station since March, working to make their way to the remote island of Nukuoro. They accompanied National Pastor Ray Ezekias and his family and are currently working to plant a church on Pastor Ezekias' home island. Please pray for these folks as there are very limited resources on this atoll in the middle of the Pacific.

We are excited to report that new opportunities have opened up to minister the truth of God's Word. While the Lord continues to bless the Wednesday night English speaking Bible Study, I have also taken over the men's English Speaking Sunday School class which was previously taught by Pastor Ezekias. Susan has begun helping to teach the English Speaking Adult Ladies class.

While God has been working on hearts, the enemy continues to work against the hardware. Power outages occur nearly every day and because of that, they take a toll on our electronic equipment. Two weeks ago, one such outage fried the contacts on our inverter from our back-up power supply as well as our studio sound board. Thankfully, after piecing things together, we were back on the air in less than an hour. Though we are glad to be broadcasting, we no longer have back-up power and are still in need of a new sound board. For several weeks, the Government station was off the air leaving us as the only station able to reach all of Pohnpei and the outer islands. This makes it all the more imperative that we stay "on-the-air" with the Gospel, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Please pray that God would supply for the necessary repairs and equipment. Thank you for your faithfulness to hold the ropes for us.
