We love being here serving God on the island of Pohnpei but having those warm gestures from home helped to soften the ache of missing that which is familiar.

Have you ever wanted to know something about God or His Word, but you were too embarrassed to ask? A few months ago, one of our dear faithful ladies in the English speaking Bible study asked a question. Several years earlier, Mrs. Aida had trusted Christ as her Savior, but she was unsure about baptism. She had been sprinkled as a child but came to realize that baptism doesn't get a person to Heaven. Thank the Lord for the opportunities He gives us to serve Him.
