Many have referred to him as the "Apostle Paul of the Islands." God used Pastor and Mrs. Welles to reach hundreds here in the Micronesian Islands and around the world. Aside from founding the very first Baptist church on the island of Pohnpei, he was also instrumental in helping to start six other independent Baptist works here. Along with his church work, Pastor Welles also began the Calvary Christian Academy, which currently serves to educate over 300 students K-12. He also worked closely with Missionary Dave Arthurs to get the Calvary Baptist Radio on the air, which has been broadcasting the Good News for nearly 30 years. During his decades of ministry, he preached over 4,000 radio messages, which are still touching lives today. Though we rejoice to know that he is in the presence of our Savior, this soldier of the cross will be sorely missed.

The quarter began with the opportunity to preach the opening service of the Spring Revival at the Capitol Hill Baptist Church in Palikir. Unfortunately, the Pastor was not able to stay for the entire week of revival meetings as medical issues took him to the Philippines for treatment. After the revival, I spent the following four Sundays filling the pulpit until Pastor Padock was able to return. Though we thoroughly enjoyed our time with the dear folks at the Capitol Hill Baptist Church, we are very thankful that Pastor Padock has returned and is doing much better.

One of the highlights of any quarter is the opportunity to preach to the young people at the Calvary Christian Academy. I was asked to speak to around 80 K-4 to 2nd graders.
