Dear Family and Friends,

We thank the Lord for the many blessings He heaps upon us through the faithful prayers and generosity of folks like you. Our quarter began by saying good-bye to one of our most faithful prayer warriors, Mrs. Marlene Liles of Kinston, NC. When Susan's mother passed away, she stepped in and adopted us, treating us like we were her own children and daily prayed for us. Over the years we have seen God work in amazing ways in direct answer to her prayers. Her notes, calls, and care packages have been a constant encouragement, especially on the field. On October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017, she went home to be with the Lord, ending her battle with cancer. We miss her terribly, but are comforted in knowing that she is rejoicing in Heaven with our Savior. She truly exemplified James 5:16, "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man (or woman) availeth much."

On the morning of November 10<sup>th</sup>, a Baptist flotilla consisting of two 20' skiffs and eleven men set out for the remote atoll of Pakin. As we departed, a storm was brewing to the North making conditions less than ideal. Our boat from Kolonia rendezvoused with the boat from Uh at the edge of the barrier reef in a place called Palikir Pass. As the boats pulled alongside one another, we cut off the engines, discussed our contingency plans, and then bowed our heads asking the King of Heaven to bless our effort to proclaim His name in the regions beyond. An hour and a half later, with 27 miles of open ocean behind us, we crossed the shallow reef along a narrow run flanked by jagged coral heads and safely arrived on the island of Nikilap. The Chief (the "Somas") greeted us at the beach while an elderly lady placed fresh coconut oil on our forearms to welcome our group. After we were given a short tour of the island, we set up for an activity with the young people. When school dismissed, just over a dozen kids joined us for games directed by Pastor Solomon David, followed by singing led by Pastor Rickson Kehling, and a Bible lesson given by Brother Melvin Afgas. Later that afternoon, we met at the island gathering house to prepare for the evening service. Soon, nearly everyone on the island had come out to hear from their visitors. Our men sang several songs and gave testimonies of God's grace. Pastor Rickson Kehling interpreted the message as I preached from John 3:16 about the need for every individual to put their faith in the finished work of the Lord Jesus Christ. The islanders listened intently, and during the invitation four precious souls prayed to be saved. Among those were both the Somas (Chief) and his wife. She would later share with one of our men that this was the first time in her life that she had ever heard a clear presentation of the Gospel. Praise the Lord!

The next day we had one more service with the kids, then packed up to make the trip back to Pohnpei. Many of the islanders gathered to say goodbye giving me the opportunity to distribute several solar powered radios pre-tuned to the Baptist Radio. As we boarded our boats, the Somas thanked us for coming to bring the Good News to his people and invited us to come back again for a longer stay. Please pray for these new believers to grow in the Lord and for God to raise up a national who could move to the island and minister the truth of God's Word to these dear people. Also pray for us as we work to plan another outreach trip to this very needy place.
