Re: **Road Construction in Soamwoai, Kitt**

I represent Nahnalek Kitt. My client was seeking to judicially stop an ongoing road construction (access road) by Andolin Astete). However, upon review of available legal documents on the lands in recent days, my client has found that she may not, at this time, legally stop such work. This memorandum does not suggest in any manner that the legal claims of my client are abandoned for other lands that my client inherited from her late father. This memo only applies to Soamwoai, Kitt and the ongoing access road construction.
