We want things to move quickly, but please pray that God will deliver us from the temptation of being apathetic or procrastinating about the things that need to be done.

Continue to pray as we give out the Gospel to people. Pray that we are faithful to God's great commission. I had the privilege of preaching one night to the youth during the Pohnpei Summer Camp this year.
