She was admitted for the night, and scheduled for surgery the next morning. Thankfully, we were blessed to know that our children were being well taken care of by the Engle family. The surgery went well on Thursday, and Brittany was able to go home the same afternoon.

By Sunday, she was having an enormous amount of pain again. We made it to the local hospital which ran some tests and gave her pain meds. The hospital in Gainesville wanted to see her to make sure that it wasn't surgery related since they performed the

surgery.

She ended up staying in the hospital on Monday and left Tuesday after they concluded that a stone had gotten stuck in her bile duct due to the gall bladder removal. Apparently, this happens pretty often. She passed the stone sometime while in the hospital on Monday and enormous relief came.

We are so thankful for the Engle family's willingness to jump in and take care of our kids. We are thankful for Brittany's parents who were willing to drive up late Sunday night from FL to stay with the kids as well. We are thankful for Pastor Mason and Shining Light Baptist Church for their understanding and generosity in loving on our family. We are truly blessed!
