January has just flown by! We have been traveling in Tennessee, North Carolina, and Florida with our last meeting in Ohio. This last big trip had to be broken up into three trips because of the accident, but we were able to make all of our meetings because some of the pastors were willing to move a couple of our meetings. I am thankful for the willingness of these pastors to help in a time of need and for the great meetings we have had in January.

We are having our church sendoff the weekend of the 21st of February and we are now leaving for Micronesia in less than a month. We are flying out on February 25th from Detroit Metro at noon. We are planning on working with my parents for at least a year on the island of Kosrae. There we will be helping train a national pastor, work in a Bible Institute, train a national to work with the teens, start a Ladies' Bible study and anything else that Dad needs help working on. We are excited to start our Micronesian ministry. This has been a burden of mine since I was 6yrs old and now we are only a month away. I lived out in the islands as a child, but now I am the missionary with my family. We are looking forward to the blessings and challenges that God has for us in the islands.
