Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

The people on Kosrae are so blinded by their religion and traditions. Megan and I just got back from a funeral of a 61 year old lady named Shra Anton. We received word a couple of weeks ago that she was in the hospital, but was going to be released soon. Yesterday, we found out that they were calling the children to come and say goodbye, and that the national church was holding a special service for her. In this service, they allowed her to write her name down in the 'book of life,' which their church controls. At the burial service, the national pastor assured the family that Shra was now in Heaven, because of this special service. Thank the Lord that a couple of years ago, my mother showed Shra that the only way to Heaven is through Jesus Christ. She accepted Him as personal Saviour. She is now in Heaven, but not because her name is written down in some book on Kosrae. Please pray for her family, as some are very faithful to our services and others still place their faith in a false religion.

While talking with one of the lay pastors of the national church, I asked him what was taking him to Heaven. He told me that we had to obey the commandments that God gave us. I asked what happens when we don't always obey the commandments and found that he did not know how to answer the question. I went on to explain that we could never obey them all, and that the only way to Heaven is through Jesus Christ. He told me that he had been saved, but as we left, Pastor Henry explained that his 'salvation' was confessing his sins to the church and they forgave him of his sins. The devil has blinded folks all over this world with religion. Pray for Bernie and his salvation. He listened to the Gospel and also left the door open for us to return.

We started a game night for the youth once a month on a Friday night and had a good turn out the first night. We had two new visitors and two young people who have not been in church for a while. Henry was one that my dad has witnessed to, but pressure was put on this young man to not attend our church. As I preached, I could tell that the Holy Spirit was working on his heart. Please continue to pray for him and another young man by the name of Logan. Logan just arrived on Kosrae and has made it to every Sunday service since he came. Sunday night service is all in Kosraean and this young man does not understand, but still wants to come. God has blessed the last couple of months, and we have been seeing visitors and people that came years ago in our services again. Continue to pray for the ministry and for us as God gives the increase!
