How exciting it is to write this letter and update all of you on the great progress of our new work in Tafunsak. On March 13th, we started a Sunday night Bible Study and had over twenty-five people there. We have a good group of people that are faithful to every service, and at least twenty-five people in church every week. God has been blessing; He is the One that has opened up many doors. We have seen two saved from that area, and the church in Malem has helped us knock on almost all the doors in the area. This week, I have a meeting with a young man named Judson, who told me that he is not sure where he will spend eternity if he dies. Pray that God will open his eyes and show him his need of salvation. Judson has been faithfully coming to our services.

We had a work day at the new church, where lots of men showed up to help with repairs. The building has been sitting for quite some time. The weather out here is hard on things, because if it doesn't rust, the termites will eat it, or the sun will ruin it. The structure of the building is good, but doors, windows, and some walls needed to be replaced or repaired. Now, things are looking better, and soon we will have a painting day to finish up the project. The Sunday after the workday, all the men that helped came, and were excited to show their families what projects they had helped with. Praise the Lord for a good group of men that were willing to help.

In March, I turned over the youth to Chris, and he has been doing very well. In fact, Pastor Henry and Chris are now running the Sunday night and Wednesday night services in Malem. It is nice to see these trained men taking over the work in Malem, as God has opened new opportunities for us to do. Pray that God would continue to use and help Pastor Henry and Chris as their ministries grow.

We want to thank you all for your faithful support and prayers as we minister in Kosrae. We know that the economy is not great, but you have been faithful, and God has supplied our every need. Because of your faithfulness, you too will take part in the rewards of those that have accepted Christ as Saviour. In March, a twenty-year-old young man came to me to make sure that Heaven was his home. His name is Palokea Jonas. On visitation in April, Victor Edwin bowed his head and accepted Christ's free gift of salvation. Please pray for both of these young men as they are in a discipleship program, and as they begin their new walk with God.
