Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

The Tafunsak Baptist Church has been growing, and we have had a new group of visitors coming to services. One that has been faithfully attending is a young man named Dennis, who is eighteen. He admits not knowing where he would spend eternity, so pray that God continues to soften his heart. It is because of your prayers and support that we get to see God working in these lives. The church building is also growing as we have started working on the front of the building. The church has been able to pay for its extension with their offerings. This extension will give us a room 14' by 30', which will be a foyer, classroom, and fellowship hall. We have had many of our people helping out with the building. Even a group of children showed up to haul in sand for mixing. It is exciting to see folks putting in their own time and sweat into the church.
