Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

We are back in the United States. Because of delays, our traveling took around thirty-two hours, and we are thankful that part of the traveling is over. On our first leg of the trip, the flight from Kosrae to Kwajalein is about an hour worth of a flight. Lauren thought that when the plane started to land that our trip was over. It is hard to explain to a three year old that we had another thirty plus hours left on our trip. For the most part, the girls did great traveling all that time, and we thank you so much for your prayers. Praise the Lord we made it.

At the time of this letter, we have been back for six weeks. In that time, we have driven over six thousand miles. We went from eighteen miles of pavement to endless amounts. The girls are as sick of the car as we are, but so far, God has blessed and we have had safe travels thus far. We have about sixty meetings booked in the ten months that we are back. Praise the Lord we do not have many open services on our schedule. There are some of our supporting churches that I have had difficulties getting in contact with for a meeting. The weather was a little cold for us up in Michigan, but we are feeling more at home here in Florida in June. Also, the girls were able to see snow on Mother's Day this year and were so excited to go out in the snow. Almost as fast as they ran outside into the snow, they came flying back in the house letting us know how cold it was outside.

My parents are filling in for us in Tafunsak while we are gone. They were able to get the youth group running, but we need your prayers. The two men that we placed in charge of it are having problems getting off of work to help run it. We would like to ask you to pray that God would provide someone to help out with the youth. There is only a small group right now, but next year we will have a good group of our kids moving up in that age group. Pastor Henry is now running all of the services at Calvary Baptist in Malem since we have been gone. It is nice to see a national pastor in one of the churches on Kosrae. We would continue to ask for your prayers as we look for a national for the Tafunsak Baptist Church.

Thank you for your continual prayers and support. We look forward to seeing as many of our supports as we possibly can and update you on your part of our ministry!
