Just last month, dad was able to lead him and his wife to the Lord.

Emily also had a friend, Nora, who lived next door to our house. Her parents were on another island, and her dad took a job with the Kosraen Embassy in Washington D.C. We have been praying for her and her family for some time. On our way back from a meeting in North Carolina, we were able to stop and see them. They were not going to a good church, but during our visit, I had opportunity to present the Gospel. Her dad, Raleigh, said that he accepted Christ in Kosrae as a teenager, but we could see that his wife was under conviction. Raleigh wanted to find a better church and become more involved. We were able to find one that has a bus route in their neighborhood. Two weeks later, Raleigh called me to say that his wife and her niece got saved and all of them are getting baptized.
