It was our plan to write this letter from Kosrae, but we have had a delay in our trip. Megan's sister, Amanda, is getting married in April, and we were able to move our tickets cheaper than sending Megan home for the wedding. Emily and Lauren are excited about being flower girls. Amanda visited us twice during our first term and was a blessing to us. So, our new travel date is April 16th. We have the "privilege" of "enjoying" the entire winter in this cold place.

Praise the Lord! Our meetings have ended, and the Lord kept us and our vehicle safe over furlough. We appreciate your faithful prayers. We totaled 60 meetings, about 45,000 miles, and 28 states. We were in 19 churches that did not support us, and since then, four of them have taken us on for support. In our last church, we had a great meeting. It was a church that we had visited on deputation. At that time, they were unable to take missionaries on for support, but through the growth of the church, it now has the ability. That night, the church voted and took us on! We look forward to a restful and refreshing time. We have some supplies that need to be bought and shipped out to Kosrae. The Lord provided us with the time to do so.

A couple of days ago, we were turning down our road, and three houses down, you could see smoke coming from the upstairs windows. I approached the house, and the people were in panic. I asked if I could help and a man inside asked me to come in. He needed help getting the TV off the wall! We were unable to do so, and soon the fire destroyed the house. It really started me thinking. What is my most prized possession? Too often, we forget that this world is not our home! I was able to find the people and witness to them a couple of days later. Please pray that the information I left with them would open their eyes to their need of salvation.

It saddens me to write that Lazarus is away from the Lord. He started hanging around the wrong people, old friends of his, and needs your prayers. Galatians 5:9, "A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump." This verse rings true in his life and through their influence; Lazarus has made some bad decisions.
