Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

The last couple of months, we have had some lows and then also great things happening as well. We lost the island generator for almost a week, which meant no electricity. They patched up the generator, but our main one is down with parts everywhere. I do not see a fix in sight. The worst low was concerning Albert. He has gotten upset with another church member and for the most part stopped coming. Please pray as he has started to go back to the national church and has taken some of the children with him.

However, God has blessed as well. Prayer works!!! Ishmael, who we asked prayer for last prayer letter, continues to come to services. He had a health scare and was admitted to the hospital. When I visited him, I asked about his eternity. He told me this had been on his mind since Pastor Henry and I met with him. As I presented the Gospel, there were two other people in the room. One seemed to be sleeping on his bed, but when we bowed to pray, he sat up and prayed with us. I found out later that he attends the Muslim services, because they pay him. With tears in Ishmael's eyes, he told me it felt like a burden of weight being lifted off his shoulders. I found out at that during the same time Ishmael was accepting Christ, one of my supporting churches in Michigan had a 24-hour prayer meeting for their missionaries. Maura, Ishmael's sister, had been praying for years!

Please continue to pray for Mitcher and Sam who both need to be saved. Mitcher's son, Wilson, and his girlfriend, Ruth, have started coming more faithfully. Wilson made a profession of faith while in jail through my dad's jail ministry. Ruth has only missed three of our services in the last two months. Megan and I were able to sit down and present the Gospel one afternoon. Wilson wanted some assurance, and Ruth accepted Christ as Saviour. Please pray for them as we start discipleship with all three.

Another prayer request is for the Muslims. While we were on furlough, they came to Kosrae, bought land, and are now trying to build. However, they have met some resistance. Dad played the testimony of a converted Muslim on the radio. There was a letter being signed to stop them from building. The governor has refused to sign their application of non-profit status. One of the national pastors has written a letter asking the governor to ban them from Kosrae. The letter states that they are an Anti-Christian religion disrupting our oneness due to Christianity on the island. He also brings up the disruption they have brought to the Marshall Islands. Quote, "The Kosrae Leadership must stop the establishment of Islam in Kosrae for today's generation and for tomorrow's." Please pray as this is on the floor of Kosrae's Congress!
