Jeff would come to church every now and then, but his wife and kids were in church every Sunday. A couple of months ago, they were having some marriage problems and asked for some counseling. There was sin in his life, but he told us that he had been saved in his teenage years. We encouraged Jeff to have a daily walk with God and to become more a part of our church. This would give him good friends and encouragement to do right.

Since then, we had only seen him once in church. As we talked at the dock, we told him that we missed seeing him at church and let us know if we can help. That night after finishing dinner, our phone rang and it was Jeff wanting to talk. He and his wife showed up at our house, and his wife asked him why they were at our house. Jeff told us that since we talked he could not stop thinking about his eternity. He told us that he had prayed a prayer, but had never had a relationship with Jesus Christ. Jeff told us that he needed to be saved! Praise the Lord!

The next week was difficult for Jeff as he was giving God his life. Many addictions were in his life and "his friends" who always asked him for help, came to offer him drinks or cigarettes. However, Jeff continued to read his Bible, pray, and come to church. We made a deal that anytime the temptations were great, he would bring his family over to our house for games or dinner. For the past month, we have had them over a lot, but he has become a testimony in Kosrae. People that are struggling with the same addictions have come to him asking how he did it. He answered them that it was not him, but Christ that gave him the victory.

Jeff is on spiritual fire and has sparked one in our church as well. In one of our services, he gave a testimony about the change that Christ has brought to his life. In that service there were several unsaved young men that had seen his change and heard his testimony. On Sunday, Jeff, another lady from our church, and three of her sons will all get baptized.

Calvary Baptist in Malem lost one of their Sunday School teachers to cancer. Sharron was only 39 and had four small children. Please pray for her husband and children. Also, one of our members lost his dad unexpectedly. His dad helped start the church in Tafunsak years ago. He had been away from God, but during our revival, he started to turn his life around! He had invited and brought visitors to our church when he was on island. At both of these funerals, the Gospel was preached and many people heard the Truth.
