We were told that September 30th would bring about some kind of information regarding when the islands would allow people to start returning, but that day has come and gone with no real news about what will happen. We also have an issue with the girls' passport renewals. We are told that they should be in around the first of the year, most likely. Again we are waiting on others, but know that it is ultimately God's timing when we will return to Kosrae.

Megan's last two appointments were delayed, but her doctor is pleased that her nerves all look good and that she passed all the other tests as well. From what we understand, Megan's POTS is a result of her veins. She will have to see a specialist to help circulate her blood better. If this does not help, she will be placed on medication. Please continue to pray for her health and the improvement of her blood flow. It is very complicated because of her low blood pressure!

We were saddened to find out that Ursula, a faithful member of our church, has passed away in the Philippines. She was one of the founding members of Tafunsak Baptist Church and a very giving lady. Ursula was a godly Sunday School teacher and a blessing to have in the church. She was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease in 2019. Her health has deteriorated very fast, and Ursula is now with the Lord. Please pray for her family, especially her sister, Liza, and niece, Sharon.

Over the last couple of months, God has placed us in unique situations. We crossed paths with a woman with two young children who had lost her husband to suicide and a man who just lost a close friend that was like a son. In each situation, we were able to tell them about Christ, Who offers the only true peace which passeth all understanding.
