

Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

During the past two months, we have been waiting for the email that gives us a date for our return to Kosrae! Our friend, Raleigh, in Washington D.C., and our church member, William, in Kosrae have helped us get into a position to go back. Without them, we would not even be on the return list or understand how to get on that list. We are so thankful for the help they have provided us and their work on our behalf.

Kosrae received the first return flight in July, the first one since March of 2020! One of the children on that flight had a false positive test in Kosrae. He had no symptoms and had tested negative in Guam before and during his pre-quarantine. On the very next day, he tested negative, but this caused a need for masks to be worn, and public assemblies were canceled. It also delayed the next flight!

We received word that we could be on the second flight because we left Kosrae for medical reasons. But this required that Megan and I be vaccinated. We are thankful that no one under the age of 18 is required to be vaccinated, which is an answer to prayer for our girls. On August 10, the President of the FSM signed a decree that all those residing in the FSM over 18 years old must be vaccinated.

The second flight to Kosrae arrived on August 23, and those folks are still in quarantine at this time. We will most likely be on the third flight, which should take place sometime in September. We have been told that we will have seven days of pre-quarantine in Hawaii and another fourteen days of quarantining in Kosrae.

Pray for us! We are excited about returning home, but there are still a lot of things that need to fall in place and be done before we leave. There have been many possible reasons that God brought us back, but getting to spend some time at our home church has been refreshing and encouraging for all of us. Both girls went to camp with their friends this summer, and the fellowship with our church, some supporting churches, and even new ones has been good.

God filled our schedule this year! Out of the eight new churches we were in, we only made the first contact for one of them. Praise the Lord for His continual blessings. He has taken care of us through car parts breaking and on sixteen-hour drives. God has placed people in our path during our time of need! We truly appreciate your faithful prayers and financial support.
