

Dear Pastors & Praying Friends,

We are so thankful to have many people praying for us. We appreciate your faithfulness, and we have seen God working. Finally, we received word in September that we could fly back to Kosrae in October. We are so thankful for this answer to our prayers. We left Kosrae in June of 2020 for Megan's health, and it has been frustrating waiting on an opportunity for us to return.

Over our time in the states, we visited some of our supporting churches, and the Lord opened the door for a few new churches to take us on for support. We had a wonderful time in the states but have missed our folks and ministry back in Kosrae. The children from the Sunday School department have grown so much. There are even a few newer faces that we have not seen before.

Our flight to Kosrae was scheduled for October 25, meaning we needed to be in Guam before our 10-day pre-quarantine started on October 15. We had our church send-off and said goodbye to both our church and family on October 3. The idea was not to have close contact before flying out, trying to limit the possibility of a positive test.

After wearing a mask for about 25-hours straight, we arrived in Guam one day early to find out that we needed to be here early for orientation. On the first day in pre-quarantine, we had our first Covid test, and both of our daughters tested positive. Neither had any symptoms, but they were not allowed to be retested. So we stayed in an isolation hotel in Guam. We were required to be isolated for ten days and then received a clearance form to leave Guam.

Those forms came a day after our original flight to Kosrae, so now we are waiting for the next flight. It gave us eleven days of freedom in Guam, and again we tried to limit our contact with people. At this time, we are in our second 10-day pre-quarantine, and all tested negative on our first test. So we have one more test to pass before we fly out on November 15 to Kosrae.

The girls continue to get a lot of school work done, but we all are fighting boredom. Sometimes it feels like we are in a zoo, waiting on our daily meals and staring out windows! Pray for us. Thank you again for all the prayers and encouragement!
