Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for your support over the recent months. The Christmas season was a busy one for me here on Pohnpei. Along with the Christmas season came the responsibility of transferring over from our regular station playlist to the Christmas playlist. The switch went very well, however I spent the next week or so gradually correcting mistakes in the programming. I believe that by the end of the Christmas season, the Lord helped me to organize the Christmas programming so that next year will be a much easier transition.

Along with my normal routine at the station, I had many other opportunities to put some of my technological skill to use during the holiday season. I was able to provide assistance with audio for several Christmas programs and also had the chance to video several cantatas and programs.

Christmas was not all about work though. There were many Christmas and New Years parties full of food, laughter, singing, and fun. One of my favorite parts of these parties, was the chance to sit around and play the guitar or ukulele and sing. These were also great opportunities for me to get to know some of the church people better. Please pray for me in this area.
