

New Ministry Opportunities

It's been a very busy past few months. We arrived back from Micronesia to PA just as Servant's Heart Camp staff training was finishing. We jumped right into camp, so that helped us to get a schedule and get over jet lag. It was a busy summer producing week-in-review videos for camp each week. Each teen, junior, and family camp, we captured footage of the events of the week and compiled it to create a short video for the campers to remember what they experienced at camp.
