Last week our family returned from our longest trip to date. We spent 9.5 weeks traveling, filming, planning for future videos, presenting the ministry, and editing.

On this trip we:

We traveled approximately 4100 miles by vehicle and several thousand more by airplane.

We visited or passed through 10 states.

We visited the country of Ecuador.

We slept in 9 different places including a hotel, prophet's chambers, a travel trailer, an Airbnb, and a missionary's home.

We reported to one supporting church.

We presented the ministry in 4 new churches (one church has partnered with us.) We worked to film 8 different videos.

- 2 Churches
- 2 Missionaries
- 1 Mission Board
- 1 Christian School
- 1 Bible Printing Ministry
- 1 Keychain Ministry (a means of soul winning)

We captured 1.3 Terabytes of video footage.

We recognize that all of this is accomplished because of God's people. Every time we filled up with gas, or sat down at a meal, or stood behind a camera, it was because of you giving for the cause of Christ.





One of the highlights of this trip was the 10 days that we spent in Quito, Ecuador. This trip was particularly special because it was the first time in years that we have been able to make a trip like this as a family. We enjoyed learning about and filming the ministry of the Ackeret family in Quito; we look forward to completing their furlough video soon.





Most of our time was spent in the city, but we were excited to get out one day and see some of the beautiful landscapes. Just writing this letter makes us realize how difficult it is to put what one sees on the mission field into words. We are so excited to show you Ecuador through our lens, but the video is still in progress.





When we returned to North Carolina, after our trip to Ecuador, we had a few days to rest and then traveled to Georgia for a few more projects. Filming for the Macedonia Baptist World Mission's Reach the World Youth Conference was a whirlwind of a day. Then we spent the next week working with Peoples Baptist Church and Academy in McDonough, GA. We are thankful for each of these opportunities.


