The first half of the trip was filled with disappointments and setbacks as we weren't able to make it to the first village and weren't able to hold services in the next two villages. Through prayer and God's clear direction, we ended the trip with several opportunities to capture meaningful content for the video through interviews with native ladies, a service with one man in attendance, and several opportunities to minister in one-on-one situations.

I believe God orchestrated and provided for us to be able to capture footage that will help to tell the story of the need of the Gospel in Alaska.

Towards the end of the trip, Missionary John Pinnix asked me if I could create a short update video for his supporting churches. With just one day to edit the update video, we created a video that gives an insight into the Pinnix's ministry, updates their supporting churches, but also recaps our time in Alaska as well.
