Over nearly 10 years of ministry, our family has stayed in countless hotels, prophets' chambers, homes, Airbnbs, a cargo trailer, and have even slept in the truck. For years, we have prayed for a travel trailer to call home on the road. At the

beginning of January, God allowed us to purchase a used trailer in South Carolina. It was a blessing to watch God open doors and clearly guide us after many closed doors in the past. On the day we purchased the trailer, we drove to our ministry opportunity in Georgia, taking us straight through Atlanta rush hour traffic. God brought us safely through. We enjoyed turning the trailer into a home over the next few weeks on the road. We spent the next 42 nights parked in 7 different locations, but with the same home every night. I like to say, "Same bed, new front yard." What a tremendous blessing.
