




# The Gali Family Missionaries to Chile

November/December 2007



Dear Pastor,

*“Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits.” - Psalm 103:1-2*

Our family’s nightly tradition is to sing Bible songs and then sing the chorus of “Count Your Blessings” with each family member giving a blessing of the day. It is a joy to hear our boys name something for which they are thankful. Our youngest son, Samuel, will often spend a few minutes naming many things - for every family member, for his pajamas, and even for the footballs that are on his pajamas. We laugh at him because he sometimes goes on and on, but our family could write several pages praising God for all He has done for us this year.

Looking back on the past ten months of this year we have much to be thankful. In January, we were receiving around 45% of our needed support. We are currently at 86%, with plans to leave for Chile in mid-April. God has greatly blessed and we thank each church that has been burdened of the Lord to reach the Chilean people for Christ. We ask that you pray with us that the final 14% will come in by April.

This year, we have traveled over 36,000 miles, had meetings in thirteen states, and presented our work in 75 churches. Every month we ask you to pray for our family’s safety, and we can say assuredly that God answers prayers. Except for a small fender-bender in New York (in which no one was hurt), God has protected our family through those many miles. Please continue to pray for us as we finish up this year with meetings in Virginia and West Virginia.

Our oldest son, Matthew, celebrated his birthday on the first of November. It is hard to believe that he is already four. We would like to thank each church that sent him a birthday card. He was excited with each card that came in the mail just for him. Thank you for making his day special. We would appreciate prayers for his salvation. Please pray that his heart will be tender to the gospel and that we will see not only Matthew, but also Sammy come to know the Lord at an early age.

It is our prayer that you have a blessed Thanksgiving and Christmas. With all the busyness that we experience during this time of year, may we remember the benefits that God loads upon us daily and rejoice in the salvation that He brings to all who call upon His name. We pray that you will be able to share that salvation with others.
