




# The Gali Family Missionaries to Chile

Dear Pastor,

On October 31, the church plant in Calera de Tango celebrated its one year anniversary. We had 35 in attendance and enjoyed a sweet time of fellowship. We were privileged to have with us a pastor from Temuco, Chile, Pastor Jaime Cid, preach the service. He preached about seven characteristics of a living church, and it was a blessing to hear the comments from our church people of how God worked in their hearts. There are so many churches throughout Chile that are full of people who only attend out of tradition, or because it is the right thing to do. It is our prayer that the work in Calera de Tango will be alive, full of members who are faithfully serving and actively bringing others to Christ.

In October, we started a Friday Bible club for the children. Last week, we had nine in attendance. It has been difficult bringing in new children because many parents are hesitant to send their children off to strangers, understandably so, but we have three girls who faithfully come and enjoy the club. Anais and Javiera also attend Sunday school and are learning their Bible verses. It is our desire to have a family church, and we pray that through our contact with these children that we will one day see their parents in church with them. Please pray for these girls, as well as, Javier, Joaquin, and Valentina that we will see them and their parents come to Christ.



Although our current church location has its disadvantages, we have been blessed with a lot of free publicity. One lady, Elba, had a dentist appointment and saw our church sign and has started to attend. She had attended a Baptist church in center city, Santiago, but now lives in Calera and can't make the long trip. We have questioned her about her salvation and are uncertain of her testimony, but we are glad to have her attend. Another lady showed up one Sunday because she saw our sign, and the following Sunday she came back with her family. David and Lorena have been faithfully attending with their two teenage sons, Yerko and Farid, and have also started weekly discipleship classes. Their thirst for knowledge has been amazing to see.



Through visitation outreach, Joel and his two children, Sara and Jeremias, have been visiting with us, as well as, a Catholic lady, Elisa. Every week, we have been blessed to have visitors, and we praise God for those He has brought in. In our evening service, Delfina, Angelica, Gisenia, Sara, and her two daughters, Sofia and Milen attend. Many of these ladies are unsaved, but praise God, they faithfully come and are in the right place to hear the Word.



God has blessed so much in these last months, and we rejoice in the increase we have seen. We have been searching for another building because with one room, Sunday school classes are difficult. We currently have three classes and hope to start a teen class soon. Please pray with us about this need. Housing in Calera is scarce and expensive, but with our God all things are possible. We know He will give us what we need at the perfect time.
