


The Gali Family Missionaries to Chile

To Pastor and Church Family,

On December 9, we celebrated Christmas with a special service. The children of the church participated in a short play, acting out the birth of Christ. Following the service, we had a time of fellowship with our church family and visitors. There were a total of 38 people in the service, and the majority of them were unsaved. We're thankful for the many visitors that God brought in to share in the special evening, and we pray to see them saved in this new year.

The kid's Bible club continues to do well, and the kids look forward to coming each week. We have several girls who come faithfully, and they have also begun attending Sunday service. Our Club verse is 2 Timothy 3:15, "And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus". We enjoy the time spent with the children each week, and we trust that God will do a work in their hearts while they are still young.

The discipleship studies continue to do well, and we enjoy the enthusiasm and interest of the people. Many of those participating in a Bible study have attended church for years, but were either never correctly taught or never given a discipleship course at all. It's a joy to hear so many questions as well as to see the burden they have begun to have for their unsaved family members. Some classes are not always easy as we are teaching a couple from a Pentecostal church. Lorena is used to her ideas and what she has been taught, and one night she became very upset. Many Chileans are Catholic in name only, but those who have experience in an "evangelical" church are often harder to deal with. They have a mixed knowledge of truth and experience that unfortunately makes it hard for them to see themselves as lost. Please pray with us as we continue these studies that the purity of God's Word will reach the hearts and change lives.

We are continuing our search for a new location for the church. We have asked several people while out visiting and they say, "It's hard to find anything here!" It may be hard, sometimes we feel impossible, but we serve a God who can do anything! Please pray that God would lead us to a building with more space for our Sunday school classes.

We would like to thank BEAMS for the Bibles they send each month for the ministry. The people are always surprised to receive such a beautiful Bible free of charge. We would also like to thank Mark Ring of Comforting Ministries, who through his ministry, provided us with many CDs of stories of the Bible. They have been well received on our visitation, and many want an extra copy for their family members. We thank each of these ministries for the blessing they have been to us.

As always we thank you for the financial support and prayers for our family and the work. May God bless in this new year of service, and may many be reached as we labor together for Him.
