We filed the paperwork needed to send our belongings by container to the apartment, and we loaded and sent it off on October 16th. We were very thankful to be able to spend time with family and friends leading up to our departure. On October 28th, we said “see you later” to them and flew to the Dominican Republic. Upon arrival, we have been taking care of all the necessary things in order to live and set up our home in the country. We are so thankful for all of the help from Ron Autrey and the members at New Life Baptist Church in Santo Domingo as we transition to living here. Please pray as the church is in process to purchase a building of their own.



We want to say thank you again for those who have sacrificially prayed and given to our family so that we can pursue the work that God has called us to do! Please pray as we continue to take care of all of the details necessary to reside in the Dominican. Also, please pray as our container (which arrived on November 1) is processed that we would receive it in a timely manner with the best tax rate possible. We are excited about the wonderful privilege to minister for the Lord in this new field of service.
