Much has transpired here in the Dominican Republic over the past two months. Thank you for your prayers for our outreaches to the children at the end of December. We visited a local orphanage in Santo Domingo and a sugar cane village in La Romana to distribute Christmas gifts and share about the Greatest Gift to all mankind. After restful holidays, we hit the ground running in January with a new school year. Tim was able to substitute teach in some of the English Bible classes as well as preach on a few occasions in the school and church. In February, we visited the surrounding areas with gospel tracts and invitations. On February 7th, New Life Baptist Church celebrated their 15th Anniversary Service at a park in the same neighborhood as the new property. The pavilion was full, and five precious souls trusted in Christ as their Savior! We transitioned immediately into a stirring revival the next two nights with a pastor from North Carolina. Tim preached the following Sunday, and another few precious souls gave their life to God! Later in the month, we began helping with the youth in their monthly meeting for the teenagers.
