We focused in the beginning on the building to house the church while we waited for the previous owners to conclude their move. The first service at the new location was on Easter Sunday, March 27, and the school held their first day on April 4th. In April, we resumed full ministries and outreaches in the church, including the youth services as well as an outreach to a local maternity ward with a gospel witness and a time of prayer with the new mothers.
