We have now been serving in the Dominican Republic for five years. It is hard to believe that we arrived in the country on October 28, 2015! Tim spoke at a conference for the Haitian churches in the southern region of the DR in September. The Lord blessed the conference as well as gave him an opportunity to begin searching for a house. He has made a number of trips to the city, but we have not been able to secure housing. One good option fell through during the lease negotiations, but we know that God has something better for us. He was also able to meet a pastor of a Baptist church on the other side of the city who has been continuing the work begun by a missionary for the last five years.

Many students that have graduated from the seminary or are currently enrolled attend this church. Our family also received our renewed visas, and we are waiting now for our identification cards to finish processing.
