Dear Praying Friends,

Encouragement has been defined as “an urging or stimulation to go forward.” In the Bible we see people are seen needing encouragement to serve the Lord as well as to perform everyday ordinary tasks. What is the source of this encouragement? The Bible lists several things that will encourage our service to the Lord and faithfulness to everyday tasks.
