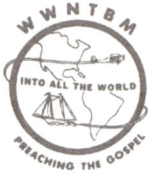
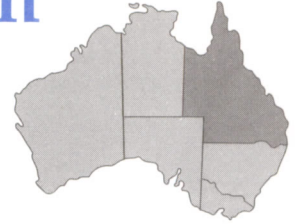

I know it has been ten months since our youngest girl passed away, but we still miss her and we believe the church folks want to help us continue to keep on keeping on.
