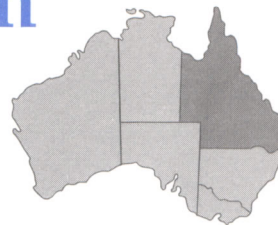

Religious Education classes have been slow to start up this year. Although we have plenty of teachers available to do all seven grades, we are being limited to grades one through six.
