

Dear Friends and Family,

It has been a little over a month since I last wrote. I had a surgery on my foot the next day after writing the last prayer letter. The doctor said the abnormal growth he removed from my foot was the largest of its kind he had ever removed. I was in hospital two days, off my feet for a solid week (of which time I had to keep my foot above my heart to help with healing). My foot still hurts, especially when I stand long, and is numb on the bottom of my foot and toes (it will take a while for the nerves to grow back properly). I may have to have some sort of orthotic to help support where the plantar fascia was removed. Thank you for praying for me and please continue to pray for complete healing.

Over school holidays, children from grades four through high school were able to attend winter camps at Camp Benaiah. We had two children to trust Christ as Saviour during that time. Others were challenged about their daily walks with the Lord. Please pray for growth in the new believers and continuance in obedience for those who the Lord spoke to about other things.

A man, who had been attending our church regularly over the last few months, trusted Christ as Saviour two weeks ago! You can certainly tell a change in him. Please pray for his growth in Christ and for him as he witnesses to his wife and co-workers.

Please pray for Religious Education classes. There have been some difficulties with scheduling as of late. Please also pray for three children in a grade one class who have all expressed interest in trusting Christ as Saviour.

Mike Coghlan, a dear evangelist and friend, went home to be with the Lord last week. Please pray for his family, many of whom are in our church. Please also pray for the many unsaved that attended his funeral and would have clearly heard the gospel.
