He has blessed us with several wonderful meetings in Tennessee, North Carolina, Georgia, Florida, South Carolina, and Montana. God has given us additional supporters along the way as well. We are now at 53% of our support goal. There are still several churches that are considering us at this time, so please be in prayer that they will be able to add us to their missions budget.

At the writing of our last prayer letter, we had a severe issue with our vehicle. The transmission had gone out in it, and it was only a year old. The Lord used this situation to allow us to purchase a good AWD vehicle for Montana. Also, the dealership bought the other vehicle back from us, which has now left us with no vehicle debt at all. Space fails me to write of how everything worked out, but all we can say is, “praise the Lord”!

At this very moment, Kayla and I are in Montana. We will be leaving the morning of August 12 to go back to South Carolina where we will begin another string of meetings. Please be in prayer that the Lord continues to bless this trip, and that he will give us safety in the coming days as we travel back to SC. This trip was scheduled so that we could find housing. At this very moment, we have been unsuccessful in securing a place, but we do have applications in. Please be in prayer that, if it is Gods will at this time, something will come through. God knows the need.

Please be in prayer for one of the communities on the Flathead Reservation just north of where we will be planting the church. It was hit by a wildfire on August 1. The fire burned over 1,100 acres, and destroyed around 20 homes. There is now a number of families who have been displaced as a result. Again, God knows the need.
