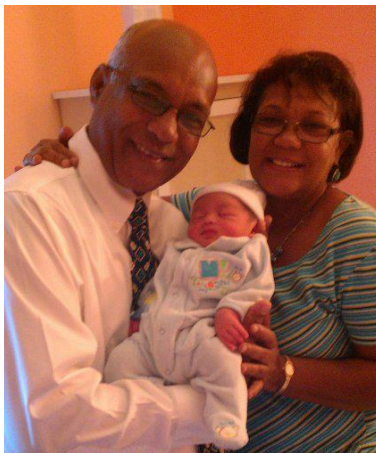


*"It is finished...." John 19:30*
