I have enclosed a site plan (right) of what we have located for the future home of the Victory Baptist Church. It is marked with an "X". The land belongs to the government of Mauritius, and we are asking that this land be given to us. Please pray that this will materialize and if not that the Lord will give us peace about another site.
