Please be in prayer for Pascal and his family as they are presently in the states. As parents, we are happy to know that for this Christmas Pascal and Becky and their five children will be together with Lionel and Grace and their four children. Here, on this side of the world, We will have only five grand children to celebrate the nativity. Hadassa is our newest addition. She is a real gift of God.

The work is doing well. The unrest that there is in the world is not so prevalent here. But, religious radicalism is manifest in other ways. This is a glaring testimony that people have set themselves against the Lord and His anointed. Every opportunity to share biblical truth is given out faithfully following the instruction of our Lord: wise as serpents and gentle as doves. Hopeful that God will give the increase.

Please be in prayer for the Malagasy community in Mauritius. These are people who are fleeing poverty and finding in Mauritius an eldorado. It is in our hearts to reach out to these who live in and around the village of RoseBelle. The same scenario is true of the Bangladesh community. Though the major problem there is the language barrier, we feel confident in the knowledge that the great commission has never been revoked.

Pray for some faithful men that God has gifted me with in the ministry here in RoseBelle. These are a great encouragement and uplift in the ministry.
