We had an Apologetics class on Thursday nights to encourage and boost the confidence of a group of young people who attend the public school. One of the fathers asked me to give some instruction to some of the

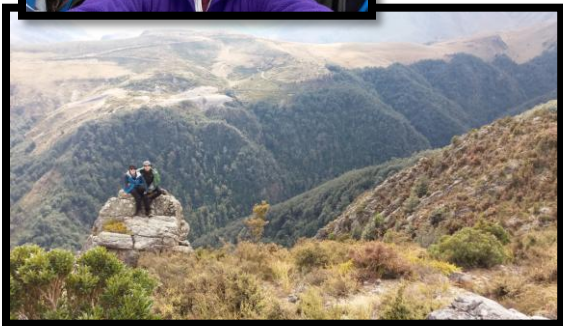


high-schoolers who are going to face ridicule and false teaching in their classes.
