#### Dear Praying Friends,

The above verses have become very meaningful to Norma and me over the last three months. Back in March, Norma began having weakness, shortness of breath, and numbness in the left arm. She had EKGs, Stress Test (which was not fully completed, due to exhaustion) and a CAT Scan. Because none of these showed a heart problem, they decided to check for Pulmonary problems. These test proved to be negative or within normal ranges. I kept pushing for an Angiogram and finally they agreed. They found one of Norma's arteries 90% blocked. Where the blockage was located, they could not use the balloon treatment, nor a Stent. If they had ONLY done this test first, back in March!!!!

The next day she was in surgery (Tues., May 13<sup>th</sup>.). They did a new procedure called "The Minimum Invasive Heart Surgery". In this procedure they do not split the breastbone, nor stop the heart. However, Norma's surgery was more difficult and prolonged because of her receiving artery being so small. She is now recovering slowly, with most of her difficulty coming from the heart medications. There are so many of these medicines and the body has to adjust to these. The surgeon, that did the procedure on Norma, is Dr. Jeffery D. Lee. He is the only surgeon in Hawaii that performs this particular surgery.
